Discussion on an ordinance regulating wireless service facilities and associated wireless support structures within the right-of-way and elsewhere in the City of Bixby.

City Attorney Tammy Ewing stated that on January 8th I had told you that a legislation had been proposed and we had been waiting for them to take it to court so I recommended that we wait and see how that was resolved and then the week of February 19th we received calls from AT&T and Horizon and I found out what was going on with the legislation and it wasn't going well for the carriers at that point. Tammy continued to explain that AT&T and Horizon wanted to plant poles in some of the dead spots in our town and what we told them you can't plant them on poles according to our ordinances and you can't plant them in the right-of-way. Tammy stated that she could work on an ordinance with the language on the legislations discussion, and would like to answer any questions that you might have.
