Consider and Approve:

- 1) Minutes for the Bixby Public Works Authority Meeting dated March 23, 2026.
- 2) Consideration and possible approval authorizing City of Bixby to extend contracts with City's approved mowing/vegetation control contractors for the 2026 mowing season. Approved mowing contractors are Prodigy Lawn and Care, Heartland Lawn Care, and Boca Outdoors, LLC.
- 3) Consideration and possible approval authorizing Mayor to approve an agreement with Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. (HUB Engineer) for the design of the Bixhoma Lake Road 12" Water line Replacement in the amount of \$105,000 for the design of installation of 5,600 LF of water line and appurtenances to replace the existing water line located in the Leonard service area.
- 4) Consideration and possible approval authorizing Mayor to approve an agreement with Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. (HUB Engineer) to serve as Engineer of Record for the City of Bixby's portion of the Spartan Creek Development Project in the amount of \$144,300 for the design of water line, sewer line and appurtenances to serve the Spartan Creek development area.
- 5) Consideration and possible approval authorizing Mayor to approve an agreement with Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. (HUB Engineer) for the design of the Sheridan Water line extension to 141st Street in the amount of \$69,100 for the

design of installation of 2,800 LF of 12" water line and appurtenances to improve services in the North Sheridan service area.

(HUB Engineer) for the design of the Leonard Service Area Water Line Replacements Phase 2 in the amount of \$345,000 for the design of installation of 10,200 LF of 8" water line, 31,100 LF of 6" water line, and appurtenances to replace the existing water line located in the Leonard service area.
- 7) Consideration and approval of purchase of three (3) bypass pumps in the amount of \$108,014.23 each for a total cost of \$324,042.69 from United Rentals, Inc.
- 8) Consideration and/or approval of the purchase of an Envirosight pipe inspection camera system, for the use of water and stormwater inspections in the amount of \$153,404.43 to Envirosight under Sourcewell Contract #120721-EVS.

21 O.S. Section 280 provides the following: A. For purposes of this section, “disturb, interfere or disrupt” means any conduct that is violent, threatening, abusive, obscene, or that jeopardizes the safety of self or others.
